SHOW ATTIRE

White collared shirts with dark pants. Exhibitors must present a neat and professional appearance in showmanship and conformation classes. Farm names and letters must not appear on clothing. No sandals, open-toed shoes, tank-tops, midriff or cropped shirts or shorts allowed.

POULTRY REGULATIONS

Cloverbuds will compete and be awarded premiums and ribbons and will follow the same rules as a regular 4-H member.

DUCK AND GEESE SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

Each exhibitor will be required to take part in showmanship. If an exhibitor is also showing chickens, they are not required to participate in Duck & Geese Showmanship classes. If an exhibitor is **only** showing duck and geese, they must enter a duck and geese showmanship class.

Each exhibitor will present his or her own bird to the judge on an individual basis.

Each exhibitor will be judged on appearance, handling of bird and presentation to the judge.

Questions will be asked on the exhibitor's breed, also on parts of bird.

The bird shown in showmanship must also be shown in its breed class.

DUCK CLASSES

Ducks and geese must be cared for daily (fed, water changed, cage cleaned, etc.).

All ducks are shown singly (duck and drake).

Female = Duck

Male = Drake

Any standard breed may be shown. No crossbreeds are to be shown.

Exhibitor is responsible for providing a large water pan for their exhibit.
