SHOW ATTIRE

Dark pants; long-sleeved white shirt. Exhibitors must present a neat and professional appearance in showmanship and conformation classes. Farm names and letters must not appear on clothing. No sandals, open-toed shoes, tank-tops, midriff or cropped shirts or shorts allowed.

PLEASE NOTE

Due to space constraints, cavy exhibitors will be limited to exhibit a maximum of 15 cavies per 4-H exhibitor. CAVY CAGE: Please bring your own flat bottom wire-sided cages.

CAVY SALES

Saturday, August 20, 2022; 5-7 pm

The cavy sale policy for exhibitors who wish to sell their animals at fair is as follows:

The <u>only</u> time animals are to be sold and picked up is on Saturday, August 20, between 5 and 7 pm.

Absolutely no money can be exchanged until this time. This will help to limit misunderstandings that may occur when people try to reserve animals by paying in advance.

Animals must be sold and removed by their new owners before clean-up/tear-down begins at 8 pm on Saturday night.

CAVY REGULATIONS

Cavy owners are responsible for the complete care of their animals while they are at the fairgrounds. Owners of animals that require special care must be available to attend to their needs.

Cloverbuds are youth ages 5-7 as of January 1 of the current 4-H year. Cloverbuds will compete and be awarded premiums and ribbons and will follow the same rules as a regular 4-H member.

Each exhibitor and parents show read and be familiar with the rules set forth in the front of the fair book under 'Rules for Exhibitors' and 'Rules for Animal Exhibitors.'

All cavy will be judged on the group award basis - - excellent, good, worthy (Danish System) but American Rabbit Breed Association Standards of Perfection will be followed.

Stock showing signs of sickness and disease will be removed from the show.

All cavy must be in place by 5 pm Monday night and remain until 8 pm Saturday. Exhibitors removing cavy before 8 pm will forfeit all premiums that may have been awarded.

All cages will be cleaned by exhibitor or all premiums will be forfeited.

Exhibitor must bring their own flat bottom wire-sided cages.

The fair will not be responsible for loss or damage to exhibits for any reason. The cavies being entered are done so at the sole risk of the owner.

Best of Show and Reserve Best of Show will be selected from class winners.

All cavy entries should be pre-registered before fair. Send entry forms to Cornell Cooperative Extension, 34570 State Hwy 10, Suite 2, Hamden, NY 13782. Entry Deadline = July 27, 2020.

All cavy must owned and cared for by June 15.

Cavy can be purebred or mixed breeding. Please enter this information on the entry form.

All cavy exhibitors will be required to show in showmanship on Tuesday at 9:30 am. If exhibitor is not present for showmanship, the cavy will not be judged on Wednesday.

The cavy shown in showmanship must also be shown in its breed class.

Cavy exhibitors must be present at the cavy judging on Wednesday starting at 9:30 am. Exhibitors are expected to present their cavy to the judge. If the exhibitor is not present, the cavy will not be judged.

CAVY SHOWMANSHIP

Tuesday, 9:30 am

Showmanship is required of all exhibitors.

Showmanship will be judged following the American Rabbit Breeders Association Standard of Perfection.

Questions will be asked on the exhibitor's breed, as well as grooming and parts of the cavy.

Each exhibitor will present his or her own cavy to the judge on an individual basis and be judged on appearance, handling of animal, and presentation to the judge.

The cavy shown in showmanship must also be shown in its breed class.

The winner in each division will compete in the next higher division the following year.
