Section 14 – DOG

Dog show animals are allowed on the grounds for the Dog Demonstration only. For exhibitor convenience one-half hour prior to the demo and one-half hour after the demo is allowed. The only exception to this rule will be a dog used as part of a scheduled 4-H Public Presentation.

4-H Dog Obedience and Agility Demonstration

Pending if there are dog obedience and agility demonstration entry forms received... on Monday of fair week, a short 4-H Dog Obedience and Agility Demonstration will be presented by the Delaware County 4-H Dog Program, following the Draft Horse Driving Division in the main riding arena.

For dogs participating in the 4-H Dog Obedience and Agility Demonstration:

-Participants must be enrolled in the 4-H Dog Project.

-Dogs must be vaccinated for Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptrospirosis, Parvovirus, and Rabies. The dog's vaccination certificate will be checked with the entry form. A copy of the dog's health papers and vaccination records should accompany the dog when entering the fairgrounds.

-A bitch in season is not permitted to compete.

-A limping or injured dog may be excused at the judge's discretion.

-All entries should be pre-registered before the fair. Send entries to Cornell Cooperative Extension, 34570 State Hwy 10, Suite 2, Hamden, NY 13782 by **JULY 27**.
