- 1. The 4-H Parade will take place prior to the Heroes Parade.
- 2. If your club's banner is stored at the Extension office, 4-H staff will bring your banner to the Youth Building to be put on display during fair week.
- 3. If your banner is not stored at the Extension office, please get your banner to the Extension office the week before fair as the banners are hung in the rafters prior to fair.
- 4. Clubs need to let the Extension office know they will be participating in the parade and if they will be picking up their banner prior to the parade.
- 5. Clubs must forward a write up which will be announced during the parade.
- 6.4-H staff will not be bringing banners to the parade line-up.
- 7. Clubs need to pick up their banners in the Youth Building prior to the parade.
- 8. After the parade, please drop off your club banner at the Youth Building so it can be put on display with the rest of the club banners.
- 9. If your club has not made a banner, contact the Extension office to obtain banner felt.
- 10. Clubs will receive participation ribbons and equal premiums.
